President Vanderschuere called the meeting to order at 1:28 pm.

Approval of Agenda:

Swearing in of Newly Elected Board Members:

• William George, Kevin Deardorff, and Scott McCulloch were sworn in as newly elected board members.

## Resolution 2023-4 The Board of Directors Expressing Their Appreciation to Kenneth Judd:

- Mr. Judd provided exceptional service as a member of the Board of Directors from August 2022 through May 2023.
- Resolution 2023-4 has been resolved, approved, and adopted by the board of directors.

#### Review of Minutes:

- Minutes from April 20, 2023, Board Workshop and Regular Meeting accepted.
  - Deardorff motioned to approve, George second, all aye.

#### Review of Financial Statements and Check Summaries:

- Jeff Hodge states he believes we are on track and customers are starting to use irrigation.
- Approval of Financials
  - George motioned to approve, Deardorff seconds, all aye.

### Election of Officers:

- Board President Nomination:
  - Deardorff nominates Wayne Vanderschuere, George seconds, all aye.
- Board Vice President Nomination:
  - Deardorff nominates William George, Vanderschuere seconds, all aye.
- Treasurer/Secretary Nomination:
  - Vanderschuere nominates Kevin Deardorff, George seconds, all aye.

## Bidding Policy-Professional Engineering Services:

- RFQ for General Professional Engineering and Specialized Consulting Services for DWSD discussed.
- The Board recommended some modifications and Hodge said he will work with legal to make some changes and look at any imbalances in the RFQ.
- Approval of RFQ to be refined between staff and legal and issued to screen prospective engineering firms for water and wastewater services.
  - Deardorff motioned to approve, George seconds, all aye.

## Resolution 2023-3 Appointing Jeff Hodge to the UMCRWTF Operations Committee:

- IGA calls for the Board to formally appoint our representative on the Operations Committee.
  - o George motion to approve, Deardorff second, all aye.

## Bid Awarding of 16A Flow Control Vault and Process Piping:

- Approval for Bid of 16A to KR Swerdfeger Construction, LLC
  - George motioned to approve, Deardorff second, all aye.

## Hoelting Audit Presentation by Tom Sistane:

- Field work for the audit was performed at the Holbein office in mid-March 2023.
- No negative findings on internal controls.
- Financial Statements received an unmodified/clean opinion.

## LRE ASR Presentation by Joel Barber:

- Discussed historical water level analysis done in 2013 compared to 2023 to determine water level trends.
- Well water levels continue declining and pose a long-term challenge for well field operations and will increase operations and maintenance costs. Lower water levels take more energy to pump.
- Supply is not guaranteed for future generations.
- ASR can provide an opportunity for cost-effective storage.
- LRE has completed draft permits (90 % done) to send to the DWR and EPA, which will need to be finalized when there is a final pilot facility design.
- Gracely stated Well 1A or 9A would be the best for pilot testing.

- Grants are available, specifically the CWCB Water Plan and/or USBR grant. LRE can help complete any grant applications.
- Realistically if the Board approved this project, the timeframe to begin would be the first half of 2025.

# General Manager's Report by Jeff Hodge:

## The Loop Water Authority:

• During the Loop meeting on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023, selection of a project manager was on the agenda. Palmer lake is looking to come on board.

### Arkansas Valley Water Forum:

- Attended meeting along with all Donala Board Members.
- Presentation about the Loop and the CSU reuse from Jessie Schaffer and CSU.

#### Colorado Reuse:

- Attended on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, discussed direct and indirect potable reuse.
- Also, attended a separate meeting where they discussed upcoming technology and strategies.

## Water Report by Ronny Wright:

- Had 4 VFDs become available. They were shipped ahead of schedule, but 3 of 4 were damaged in shipping so they were sent back. They will be providing us with new ones. This will not delay 16A work. Everything is still on track.
- Well field study is progressing, only one left.

## Wastewater Report by Mike Boyett:

- In-house and Colorado Analytical analysis results were all well within permit limits for the past month.
- Bod5 influent had a removal efficiency over 98%.
- TSS influent had a removal efficiency over 98%.
- #2 SBR is still on-line. #3 SBR's motive pump has been repaired and #3 SBR is in reserve.
- The recent rain event has caused problems keeping up with the 2 times normal flow. We were forced to send excess EQ basin flow to #3 SBR for storage until the rain stopped. We are now slowly sending the water in #3 SBR to the influent to drain the tank. However, the SBRs handled the flow and continue to perform well.
- The Forest Lakes flow is now showing up on our SCADA screen after Timberline fixed the communication issues with the flow signal to our SCADA.
- Our UV system failed during the evening of Friday May 5 and did not send an alarm to the on-call operator. It was off until Sunday morning, May 7. I am preparing a letter for CDPHE due to this being a permit violation. Additionally, we are going to ask Timberline to create an alarm for any UV issue that may come to SCADA going forward.

## Consultants Comments:

- Sams stated that collaboratively Donala and GMS have terminated our painting contract for tank rehab due to time constraints.
- Gracely stated the lawn irrigation return flow process will be completed before the end of the year.

## Directors Comments:

- Miller asked what the benefits of ASR would be to DWSD if we were the only participants.
- Barber stated there will still be a benefit to Donala without a collaborative effort it will just be smaller.

• Deardorff asked if tiered wastewater rates will still begin in July. Hawker stated that they will, and staff will be sending out a newsletter with the next billing.

• Miller motioned to accept, George seconds, all aye.
